

## Hardware Description



LED: 1.5V or 3.3V power light indication

#### Jumper Setting(J1):

- 1. Short 2-3 (Default)
- 2. Short 1-2 if PCI-3V3AUX is not available on the PCIe slot

#### Hardware Installation

General instructions for installing the card are provided below.

- 1. Turn OFF the power to your computer.
- 2. Unplug the power cord and remove your computer's cover.
- 3. Remove the slot bracket form an available PCIe slot.
- 4. Carefully align the card to the select PCIe slot and push the board down firmly. But gently, until it is well seated.
- 5. Replace the slot bracket's holding screw to secure the card.
- 6. Connect the PCIe-to-ExpressCard Adapter's USB port to an available USB port on the computer with the USB A-A Extension Cable.
- 7. Replace the computer cover and reconnect the power cord.
