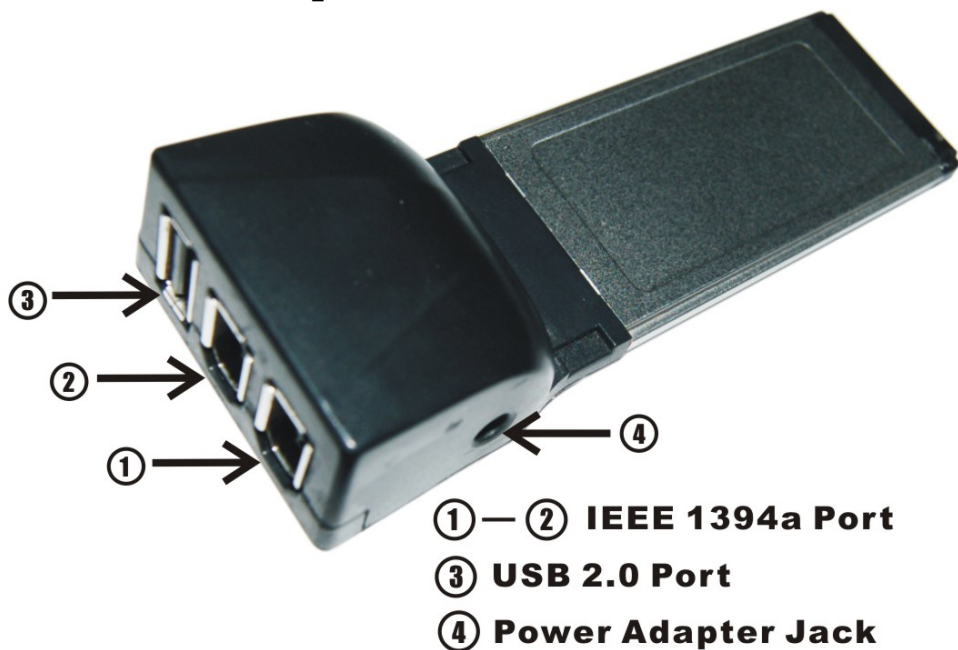
System Requirements

CAUTION:

Use only switching power adapter with following specifications:

- Switching power adapter (Optional) DC 12V, 1A
Polarity: Outside negative voltage(-) & Inside positive voltage(+)
3.5mm power jack



Hardware Installation

General instructions for installing the card are provided below. Since the design of system may vary, refer to your system's reference manual for further information, if needed.

Insert the Card into the ExpressCard slot of your system. Make sure it is inserted all the way in for a solid connection.

Driver Installation

Important: If your system doesn't boot to Windows properly with our card installed, check with your system's manufacturer for the latest system firmware update.

For Windows® 2000/XP/Server 2003 SP1/Vista

Note: Server 2003 Server Pack 1 or above is required to install the 1394a + USB 2.0 ExpressCard successfully.

Windows® 2000/XP/Server 2003 SP1/Vista will automatically detect and install the correct driver for the 1394a + USB 2.0 ExpressCard.

Inserting/Removing Devices

When inserting/removing your FireWire device, hold the ExpressCard and make sure it does not move around inside the slot, otherwise, the ExpressCard may lose connection or should be ejected from the system.
